When studying abroad, lots of students live in homestay accommodation. Homestay means staying with a local family, which gives students a very good opportunity to learn and practise their English in everyday situations. It also helps them to understand the culture of the country.

Homestay guarantees a certain degree of comfort: a family provides you with a private room and all necessary furniture like a bed, a table or a desk, and a wardrobe. You are supposed to have two meals (breakfast and dinner) with the family.

Naturally, when you stay with a host family, you should observe the rules of co-existence. Here is the list of some of them:

- *Be polite and friendly with everyone in the family.*
- *Keep your room tidy and help with housework when necessary.*
- *If you use the kitchen, do not forget to wash up after yourself.*
- *Wash and iron your clothes yourself. Do not forget to ask for your hosts' permission to use the washing machine.*
- *Never invite your friends without asking for permission. Make sure that your party is not too noisy and that you do not cause any inconvenience to your hosts.*
- *Don't stay out till late. Your host family is responsible for your safety.*

Staying in a hall of residence is another option for young people when studying abroad. You can have a single room or share a room with one or several students. The kitchen and the bathroom are usually used on a shared basis and this is one of the reasons why you should keep them clean and tidy. In the kitchen you can find everything necessary – pans, kettles, cups and plates – so that you can cook your meals yourself.

One of the advantages of staying in a hall of residence is that you can make lots of new friends there. There are usually people from different countries and you have to communicate in a multi-cultural environment which is a good opportunity to practise language and your communication skills. Your new friends may possibly help you with your homework, reports and essays, and you can also have lots of fun together. Halls of residence tend to have more of a party atmosphere and the staff often arrange different activities to help you make friends and enjoy your stay. There are usually opportunities for doing sports.
